



John Cordell Scholarship Award

1. Statement of Purpose:

To provide a graduating Glynn Academy Band member who has demonstrated dedication, leadership and musicianship with a scholarship to assist in reducing the expense of obtaining a college education.

2. Eligibility:

All Glynn Academy Band students who meet the following requirements:

- Be a member of the graduating Senior class of Glynn Academy High School
- Been enrolled in the Glynn Academy Band program for both the Fall and Spring semesters of their Senior year
- Have been accepted to a college or university for the fall semester (*a copy of a college or university fall schedule must be presented to the band director before the fall check can be issued*)

3. Nature of Scholarship:

A renewable scholarship in the amount of \$250 per semester for a total of \$500 for the period of one year.

Requirements for renewal of the scholarship include:

- Full-time enrollment in a college or university
- Second semester schedule must be turned into the Glynn Academy Band Director before the treasurer of the G.A.B.B. can issue the check.

4. Application Process:

All applicants must submit a minimum of a 200 word essay (preferably typed) to the Glynn Academy Band Booster Association. Essays should include the following:

- Cover sheet including your name, address, and telephone number
- Number of years in the Glynn Academy Band
- Your accomplishments as a member of the Glynn Academy Band
- Your accomplishments as a student at Glynn Academy or your previous High school
- Tell us about any musical activities that you participate in other than the Glynn Academy Band
- Tell us about any community volunteer activities that you participate in
- Tell us about your current college plans/goals
- Tell us about your current career plans/goals
- Tell us what it means to you to receive this scholarship
- Include any additional information that you would like to share

Students who are awarded the “John Cordell Scholarship” are required to be present at both the Glynn Academy Band Awards Night and Honor’s Night at Glynn Academy High School.
